5 CONTROLS REQUIRED

Hazard	Essential Controls	Okay with controls
1	Be alert to client calls for spillage clearance and respond quickly. Have a trolley set up at all times.	√
2	Ensure that safety signs are left around the area until completely dry	√
3	Wear rubber gloves and use extreme care	√
4	Dispose of broken glass only in labelled and sealed containers and do not mix with other rubbish	√
5	Only use odour free products in food stores	√
6	Trolleys are never to be left unattended on the sales floor	√
