## **Method Statement**

1 Task Dusting, damp dusting, washing and polish application

**2** Equipment Gloves, warning sign, dusters, detergent, 2 hand buckets, cloths

colour coded cloths, and furniture polish

3 Method

# A. Assemble equipment

### **B.Dusting**

Using clean, dry duster wipe surfaces from top to bottom using overlaping strokes

Ensure corners are cleaned

Re-fold duster as necessary do not shake or flick duster

Obtain clean duster as necessary

## C.Polishing

Ensure all surfaces are dry

Spray small amount on to duster DO NOT spray directly on surface. Apply evenly to surface.

D. Damp Dusting

Wearing gloves, three quarter fill a hand bucket with water.

Add detergent (as per manufacturers instructions) to the water. Tightly wring a cloth out in the solution ensuring it is only damp. Clean surfaces using smooth, overlapping passes.

Rinse cloth frequently in solution. Change solution when it becomes dirty.

## E. Washing

Wearing gloves, three quarter fill 2 buckets with water. To one bucket add detergent (as per manufacturers instructions) to the water. Apply detergent solution to the surfaces using a loosely wrung cloth and starting from the bottom working up to the top. With the cloth tightly wrung out in detergent solution, remove the liquid again, working from bottom to top.

Using the second bucket containing water only and a fresh cloth which is loosley wrung, apply rinse water to the surfaces. Remove all traces of liquid from the surfaces.

F. Return all materials and equipment to store

G.Return all cleaned equipment to store

H. Check area is clean and dry
