Method Statement

1 Task Toilet and Urinal Cleaning

2 Equipment Warning sign, gloves, detergent, toilet detergent, spray bottle,

hand bucket, colour coded cloths, abravise pad, toilet brush

and waste bag

3 Method

- a. Collect equipment
- b. Display caution sign
- c. Ventilate area, if possible.
- d. Put on gloves and any other personal protective equipment as indicated in the COSHH assessment
- e. Empty waste bins

TOILETS:-

Close lid and flush toilet

Using toilet brush, push back water to reveal water line.

Apply toilet detergent to inside of toilet bowl and under the rim.

Three quarter fill bucket with water. Fill spray bottle with water to correct level and then add detergent (as per manufactures instructions)

Using spray bottle, apply cleaning agent to all items to be cleaned within toilet cubicle.

With colour coded cloth well wrung out in fresh water bucket, wipe clean all sprayed items.

Rinse cloth frequently. Then wipe cistern, flush handle, outside of toilet bowl, top of lid

then underside of lid, top of seat, underside of seat, top of bowl and hings.

Scrub inside of toilet bowl with brush until clean

Flush toilet rinsing brush in clean flush water

With dry cloth or paper remove excess liquid from cleaned surfaces

Check and replenish toilet paper

URINALS

Allow to flush

Remove debris from outlets and channels into waste bag

Apply toilet detergent to inside of urinal

Spray items to be cleaned with detergent solution

Wipe all items from clean to dirty, rinsing frequently in bucket of water

Brush inside of urinal until clean

Allow urinal to flush, rinsing brush in clean flush water

Remove all materials and equipment to store cupboard

Clean and check all equipment

Remove caution sign

NB DO NOT MIX CHEMICALS, AS POISONOUS GASSES MAY BE RELEASED
